 - Seat 11 Currently titled Vulnerable Populations. History: January 2018 LEPC voted to change title of seat to Access and Functional Needs at next By-Laws Change. Discussion: Current seat holders recommend leaving title as Vulnerable Populations.
 - Seat 12 (New) Healthcare System. History: January 2018 LEPC voted to add a new seat for "Members of organizations that represent the local healthcare system".

Recommendation: Add new seat, with the condition that the CBJ Law Dept. will develop the final title and description language.
